Punch Bowl

Originally Angus Curling Association's first annual trophy. Won by Forfar on 14th January 1886. Used since 1947 for the Club League competition.

Pattullo Trophy

For Novice Skips. Played In a league, then knockout basis. Instituted 19th October 1972.

Adamson Rosebowl (Mixed Trophy)

Played with Forfar Ladies. Played as a league. Instituted 1974

Raeside Trophy

Played as a league. Originally a knockout competition. Instituted 1976.

Kelman Stone

For Skips and thirds, played as a progressive. Played as a double round robin.

Bruce Walker

One-day club bonspiel. Played as a round robin.

Geordie Quiach

Snuff Mull

Presented to Forfar for annual competition by William Steel M.D., past Vice President, January 1857. Played for on and off until 1912. Then a gap till 1957. Since then has been awarded to the winner of the annual points competition.

Forfar Challenge Trophy

A knockout competition involving one rink from the following clubs:- Aberlemno, Evenie Water, Forfar, Fotheringham, The Angus Glens. Instituted April 1955.
